As you know this office made a plugging demand on Western Ranchers Oil Company through Mr. Ira M. Young on February 3, 1960, concerning the above-captioned well. The deadline of April 1, 1960, was not met and our demand was ignored.

We now make formal demand that United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company properly plug this well and receive approval thereof from the Artesia District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission prior to June 1, 1960.

Since it is undoubtedly a matter of concern to your Company, I have been instructed by the Commission to notify appropriate surety companies that hence forth the deadline set forth in a plugging demand to a surety company will be strictly enforced in the absence of a most compelling reason for an extension of time and the fact that the surety

Henceforth, any failure of the surety company to meet our plugging deadlines will result in appropriate legal action, a refusal to accept any more bonds from that company, and a notification of the situation to the Commissioner of Insurance.

In this connection, I would point out that the two Consolidated Gas Equipment Company wells in Curry County drilled under a bond with your Company, have not been plugged in accordance with our demand of January 4, 1960. I trust you will rectify this situation immediately.
