Dear Mr. Armstrong:

We are in receipt of a request from the bonding company for cancellation of a bond for Malcolm and Morrow Oil Company. A check of the file in our office on this well shows that the last form filed was a report of the result of test of casing shut-off on October 13th, 1953. The well file also contains a copy of a letter from Mr. Hanson to Mr. John Morrow under date of January 18th, 1954, advising him to obtain a permit for temporary abandonment of this well. The file in our office does not indicate that any such permit was ever obtained.

Please check the file in your office and advise as to the present status of the well. If your file does not show any more information than the one in our office, it will be necessary for you to contact the operator in Roswell.
