On March 15th, 1945 at 8:30 PM, 48 hours will have elapsed since setting 1171 ft. of 10-3/4" 40# SH Casing with 75 sacks of cement to be used as surface string. At this time, casing shut-off will be tested as follows:

The hole will be bailed dry and allowed to stand for one hour, and if this test is OK cement plug will be drilled, and hole will again be cleaned and bailed dry and allowed to stand for one hour. If this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.
