DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 17th, 1945 at 6:30 PM, 94 hours had elapsed since setting 1171 feet of 10-3/4" 40# SH Casing with 75 sacks of cement to be used as surface string. Casing shut-off was tested as follows:

The hole was bailed dry and allowed to stand for one hour and casing shut-off tested OK. Cement plug was then drilled and hole again bailed dry and allowed to stand for one hour. As this test, too, was OK, drilling operations were resumed.
