Reference is made to the above-captioned well on which a Notice of Intention to Drill was approved by the Oil Conservation Commission on January 19, 1959.

Since the subject well has been inactive for a considerable period of time, it must now be permanently and properly plugged in accordance with Commission Rules and Regulations. Please consult Mr. M. L. Armstrong, District Supervisor of the Oil Conservation Commission in Artesia, New Mexico, regarding a proper plugging program. In addition, please advise me of your intentions in this matter.

We will expect you to have the subject well plugged in an authorized manner no later than April 1, 1960. Should you fail to meet this deadline, we will make formal demand on your surety company to accomplish the required work. If such action becomes necessary, it will, of course, seriously jeopardize your bonding status.
