As you will recall, the Oil Conservation Commission made a demand on your Company on April 28, 1960, as surety on the bond under which the subject well was drilled, to arrange the plugging of the above-captioned well.

Subsequent correspondence indicated that perhaps the landowner, Mr. Ralph O. Pearson, might desire to assume responsibility of the well as a water well. Our District Supervisor, Mr. M. L. Armstrong, has contacted Mr. Pearson and been informed that he has no desire to utilize the hole as a water well or possible water well, and will not execute an affidavit of responsibility for conversion to water well.
