General: This form is designed for submitting a complete and correct well completion report and log on all types of lands and interests to either a Federal agency or a State agency, or both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be furnished by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal office. See instructions on items 22 and 24, and 83, below regarding separate reports for separate completions.

If not filed prior to the time this summary record is submitted, copies of all currently available logs (drillers, geologists, sample and core analysis, all types electric, etc.), formations and/or State once. See instructions on items 22 and 23, and 30, below regarding separate reports and attachments. All attachments should be listed on this form, see item 35.

Item 29: "Sacks Cement": Attached supplemental records for this well should show the details of any multiple stage cementing and the location of the cementing tool for each additional interval to be separately produced, showing the additional data pertinent to such interval.
