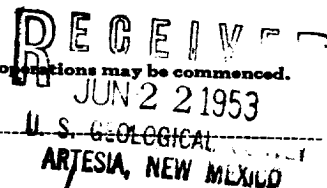
## DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to approximately 4500' with rotary tools to test the Pre-Cambrian formation. Contemplated casing and cementing program will be as follows:
