

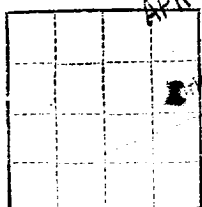

DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with verbal approval Mr. John A. Frost to Mr. R. L. Hendrickson 3-1-56 the following work was performed in permanently abandoning the above well.

Shot off and recovered 1643' 9 5/8" casing, filled hole with mud and spotted 15 sack cement plug in 9 5/8" stub. Spotted 15 sack cement plug at surface and a 4" pipe marker was erected to extend 4' above ground level. (A 50 sack cement plug at 3600-3549 was set 9-10-53).

Casing was filled and location cleared of debris.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
