## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

It was first planned to drill only to a point where good water could be obtained in order to provide a supply of water for drilling purposes but a change of plans being made proper forms are now being filed with your office. Derrick floor 4250' above seal level; 64' tall steel derrick; reinforced legs; Star 28 drilling machine; Waukesha Motor for power well drilled to 465' and 10" casing installed to this point well deepened with 10" drillbit and reamed to 12" in order to insert 10" casing to a point of 825' where the actual drilling operation for oil will begin. All forms required being mailed.
