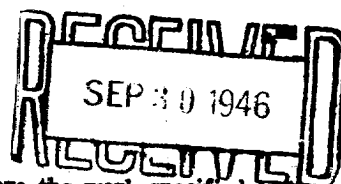

We propose to load hole with mud, spot 5 sacks cement on bottom. Will set bridge at 3250 feet, and spot 10 sacks cement - bridge at 2150 feet, and spot 10 sacks cement. Will set bridge at 1650 feet, and spot 10 sacks cement. 10-3/4" casing will be left in well and well used as fresh water well, and turned over to landowners at their request.
