In response to your letter of January 25, 1979, I shall attempt to update our well records to comply with the requirements of your office.

We have sold the lease and the well and do not have complete records, but as I understand it, you need a C-105 or 105's at this time.

A C-103 had been filed in January 22, 1976, showing a bridge plug run in the hole and left. A corrected report was filed October 3, 1978, showing the Bridge Plug pulled out.

I am enclosing three C-105's which were sent to your office in 1975 and returned to us with the attached letter. I am also enclosing sundry other reports which might help to clarify the problem.

We filed a C-103 July 18, 1978, indicating that we would plug the well, but the landowner refused to let us plug it since the lease had expired. We were able to negotiate a sale of the property to him, and a C-103 was filed showing that.

There have been no changes made in the perforations, tubing or packers and they remain as shown on the Schematic drawing and as described on the C-105's.

Since we did not plug the well, but we did transfer ownership, please advise if the copies of the original C-105's would suffice, as the originals are no longer available to us, or if we need to make new ones but showing the same information.
