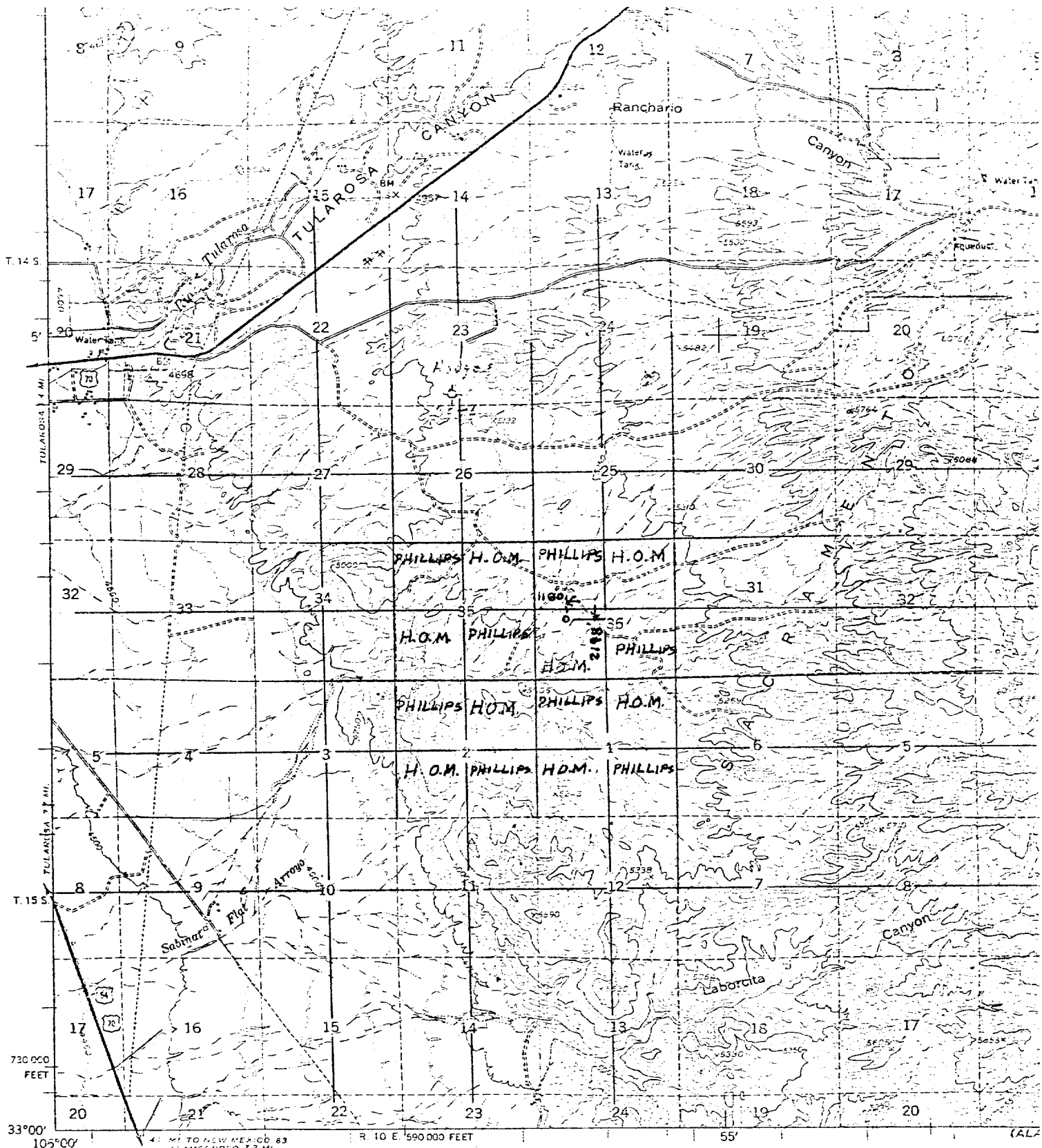

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown

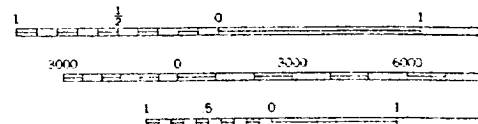
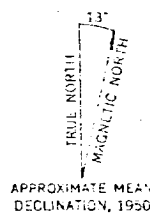
Locations of all boundaries are approximate
