2. That HOUSTON OIL & MINERALS the operator of a well drilled on land be-

longing to DON MADDOUX and JACQUELYN MADDOUX (Landowner) his wife,

OTERO, said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and described as the HOM LEWELLING No. 2, being located 674.10 feet from the NORTH line and 1983.9 feet from the WEST line of Section 10, Township 12 SOUTH, Range 9 EAST, NMPM, OTERO County, New Mexico.

3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 9487 feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows: 20" CASING WAS SET AT 334' KBM AND CEMENTED TO THE SURFACE. 13 3/8" CASING WAS SET TO 4497' KBM AND CEMENTED WITH A TOTAL OF 600 SACKS OF CEMENT. 9 5/8" CASING WAS SET TO 7997.5' KBM AND CEMENTED WITH 475 SACKS. 4. That operator and landowner have made an agreement whereby operator ~~(is not)~~ provides that operator is to plug said well back to a plugged-back total depth of 700 feet and transfer well to landowner for his use as a water-well. Operator will leave casing in the well as follows: 20" 94# CASING FROM SURFACE TO 334' KBM 13 3/8" CASING FROM 790' KBM TO 4497' KBM WITH CEMENT PLUG SET AT TOP 9 5/8" CASING FROM 4470' KBM TO 7997.5' KBM WITH CEMENT PLUG SET AT TOP.

5. That when operator has complied with the provisions of Paragraph 4 above it will so notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Commission Form C-103, together with a signed statement from the landowner that the provisions of Paragraph 4 above have been complied with to his satisfaction.
