To pull 480 feet of 6 5/8 casing, and plug the part of said well below 450 feet, and turn said well into a water well.

Fill hole with sand and gravel to 451 feet and run 5 EXC on sand and gravel which will fill hole about 30 feet, or up to 421 feet.
