1. SPUDDED @ 4:40 P. M. 2-22-73.
2. Drilled 17-1/2" hole to 545'. At 6:00 A. M. 2-25-73 circulating to run surface casing.
3. Ran 18 jts. 13-3/8", 48#, H-40, ST&C, R-2 surface casing, total 548.58', set @ 533.58', and cemented with 615 sx of Class H cement with 2% CaCl, (Dowell). Plug down 5:30 P. M. 2-25-73. Bumped plug 700 psi. Float held o. k. Lost circulation 50 bbls. before plug bumped. Cement did not circulate. Picked up 1" pipe and tagged top of cement @ 34'; cemented w/35 sx, Class H, with 2% CaCl. Good circulation to surface.
4. Waiting on cement and nipping up @ 6:00 A. M. 2-26-73. Preparing to drill out from under surface with 12-1/4" bit.

Instructions
