WELL HISTORY

Started drilling Sept. 12, 1939. Sept 15th, set 110 gt 10" new casing, cemented with 20 sacks cement. Shut off small amount of water encountered at 60 ft. No Artesian water was found in the Artesian horizon, which was to be found at 7008 745'. There was 850' ft of 7 OD used, 24 lbs. casing setaand no cement used. The well was drilled to a total depth of 961' and shut down as of Act. 4, 1939. I do not know what right they, the Artesian Conservancy Dept, had to plug this well. From the report on form C-102 it was not plugged according to the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Commission.
