Instructions

On 9-21-70, 1970, BYRON JACKSON INC. performed the cementing operation herein described for U.S. Smelting, Refining & Mining Co on their Well No. 1 on the Federal 1360 Leases lease located in Chaves County, State of New Mexico.

CASING CEMENTING: Name or type of string was Surface. Information provided by the Customer Company states that the casing was 8-5/8" in. O.D. set in 12-1/4" inch hole, and that the casing depth set was 409 feet. For this job the following materials were used:
