
In regard to the well Sharp # 1, Sec. 13-17S-26E, Eddy County, New Mexico, I have checked with Mr. Owen Haynes and find that he has not pulled the 7" casing in this well. He has removed 6 or 7 feet of the top portion to do some work on the well and has been working with the Water District on this.

In regard to the Shencke # 1, NE NE Sec 15-19S-26E, I have paid for all work of clearing of the junk and filling of the pits. There is still an oil tank on location and as soon as I can dispose of the oil in the tank, it will be taken care of.

Mr. Haynes is to take care of these matter as quickly as possible.

Another well you drilled, Service #1, Sec. 13-12S 26E, has been plugged but the location has not been cleaned of junk, and the pits have not been filled.
