However we have not encountered any cavey formation or water below 660 ft. as anticipated. We have been drilling ahead with the hole full of mud and are now about 1075 and no water or cavey formation. Desire to run 8" pipe at about 1100 feet with our cement and with only mud as we may have to underream or pull and ream if water or cavey formation is encountered
