Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

On 5-2-58 we ran 1400 feet of 5 1/2" casing to 1 in well and cemented same with 100 sacks of cement. After waiting for the cement to set we drilled the plug and tests showed complete water shut off. On 5-7-58 Powell Inc. sealoff located the well through perforations of 1322 to 1344 with 25,000 lbs. of sand and 25,000 gal. of water. Production was increased from approximately 500 bbl per day to approximately 923 bbl per day.
