FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We plan to plug the above well as follows:

Fill with cement from 522 (TD) to 500 then knock off 5½" csg and recover as much as possible. Then fill with mud to 260 and set bridge and cement ~~XX~~ plug of 5 sacks; then fill with mud to surface and cement regulation marker. Production on this well has depleted to 100 Barrells of Fluid per day, almost 100% salt water with scum of oil.
