A string of 8 1/2" used pipe was set in this hole and mudded. Testing proved that the seat was leaking. Then 50 sacks of cement was used to cement the pipe set at 703', Denton Cementing Company cementing. After allowing to set for 72 hours, the hole was bailed and tested. As no water appeared, drilling was resumed.
