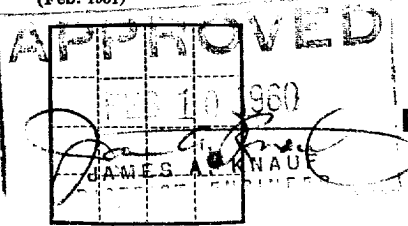

DETAILS OF WORK

On January 22, 1960 we ran 2564' of 5 1/2" OD 5rd thrd mixed 14# new ST & C and 17# used LF & C JS casing to 2564' and cemented with 150 sacks neat cement.

After standing cemented 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer.

As shut-off proved complete, drilling was resumed.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
