DETAILS OF WORK

On November 17, 1959 we ran 2112' of 7" OD Std thrd 23# used JS casing to 2115' and cemented with 150 sacks cement.

After standing 48 hours we pressured up on casing to 3100 psig. After 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer. Is shut-off proved complete, drilling was resumed.

After fracturing well, we pulled 10 3/4" casing loose and spotted 50 sacks cement from 440' to 350'.

Cementing and pressure testing done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
