

8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES:

- A. None exist in the immediate vicinity of the wellsite.

9. WELLSITE LAYOUT:

- A. Exhibit #6 shows the relative location and dimensions of the well pad, the reserve pit, the location of the drilling equipment, rig orientation and access road approach.
- B. The reserve pit will be plastic lined.
- C. A 400' X 400' area has been staked and flagged.

10. PLANS FOR RESTORATION:

- A. After finishing drilling and/or completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for further operations will be removed. The location will be cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the wellsite in an asthetically pleasing condition as possible.
- B. Unguarded pits, if any, containing fluids will be fenced until they have dried and been leveled.
- C. If the proposed well is non-productive, all rehabilitation and/or vegetation requirements of the BLM will be complied with and will be accomplished as expeditiously as possible. All pits will be filled level after they have evaporated and dried.

11. SURFACE OWNERSHIP:

- A. Bureau of Land Management; Carlsbad, New Mexico Resource Area.

12. OTHER INFORMATION:

- A. Topography: Refer to the existing archaeological report for a description of the topography, flora, fauna, soil characteristics, dwellings, historical and cultural sites.
- B. The primary surface is for grazing.
