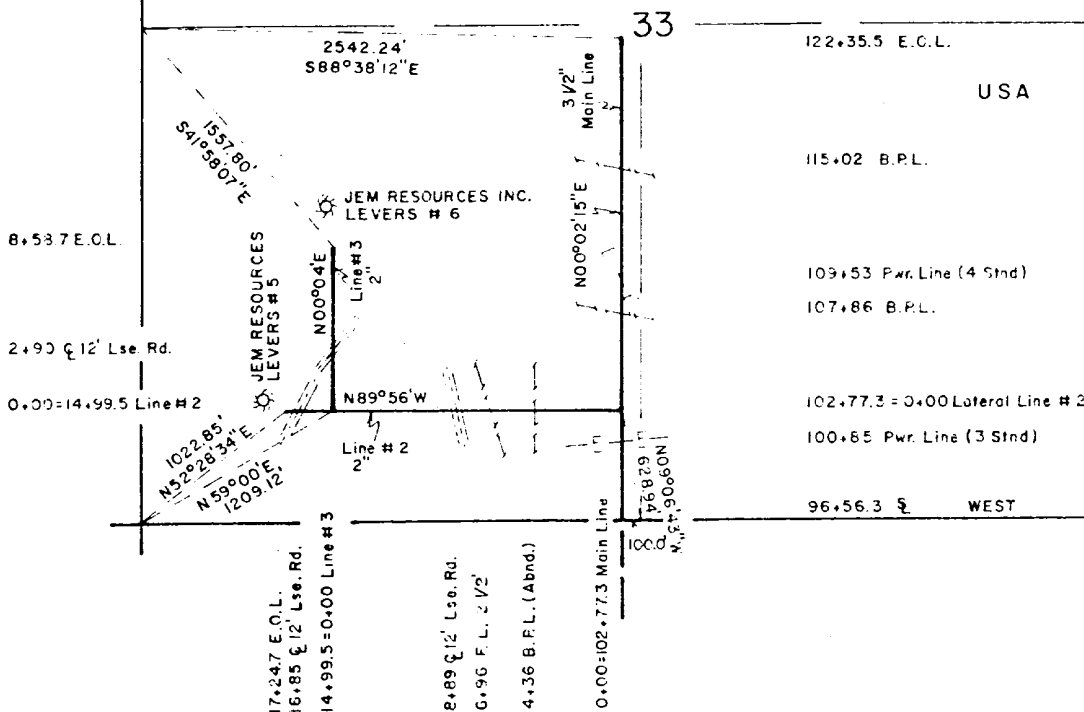
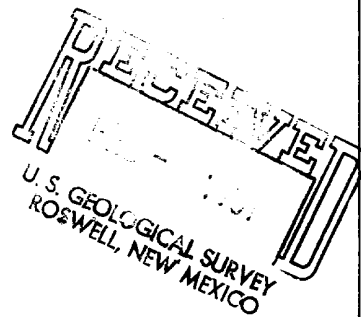

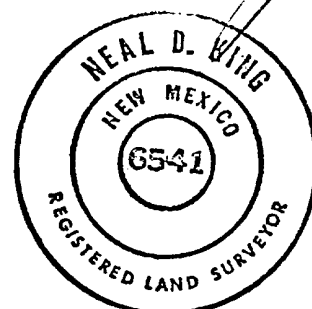

Main Line

A strip of land 30 feet wide and 2579.2 feet or 0.489 miles in length in Section 33, Township 16 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, being 15 feet right and 15 feet left of the following described survey of centerline across Federal Land:

Beginning at Eng. Sta. 96+56.3, a point which lies West 100.0 feet from the South Quarter Corner of said Section 33; thence, N00° 02' 15"E 2579.2 feet to Eng. Sta. 122+35.5, the end of the line, a point which lies S88° 38' 12"E 2542.24 feet from the West Quarter Corner of said Section 33.
