Dear Mr. Porter:

Please refer to your memorandum of February 1, 1956 on the subject of movement of oil from one lease to another for fracing, etc.

We recently moved 343 barrels of oil from our Stevens 1 and 5-A lease to our Jackson 17-B well for the purpose of fracing. The frac resulted in a well that flowed over 200 barrels of oil per day, with the result that we returned to the Stevens 1 and 5-A lease exactly 343 barrels of oil.

I assume that it is not necessary in view of the fact that the oil has been returned for us to comply with your letter of February 1. That letter seems to cover situations in which the oil can not be returned. If I am not correct, please advise and we will file the necessary notification with the Commission as required by the memorandum referred to above.
