Gentlemen:

I note that your Hawkins Well No. 1, Unit B, Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, was temporarily abandoned on February 16, 1959. On October 23, 1959 a Notice of Intention to Drill Deeper was approved by the Oil Conservation Commission. On November 3, 1959, a Notice of Intention to Change Plans was approved wherein you state that you no longer plan to reenter the Hawkins Well No. 1.

In view of the above, it appears that the Hawkins Well No. 1 should now be permanently plugged in accordance with a program approved by the Commission's Supervisor in Artesia, New Mexico.

Please arrange to do this work as soon as possible.
