- (1) Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
- (2) Notify this office in sufficient time to arrange for a representative to witness the cementing operations and water shut off tests.
- (3) Furnish this office with duplicate copies of any electrical logs or surveys run in addition to four copies of our log of oil or gas well, form 9-330.
- (4) The proposed casing program shall conform with the rules and regulations on setting and cementing casing in the Artesian Water Basin.
- (5) Form 9-329 shall be submitted in duplicate each month beginning with initial operations on the lease showing the status of the well.
