I discussed this matter with Mr. Thomas McClure this morning and showed him your letter. After some discussion it seemed advisable to us that you and he get together on Mr. McClure's next trip to the Pecos Valley and go thoroughly into this matter. I believe the chances for successful handling of it are better under this program than any other.

Mr. McClure agrees that the present loss of water is not in itself a serious matter but the general policy of his office is to eliminate all such leaks.

As I see it, we should cooperate with Mr. McClure to the best of our ability and with due fairness to all parties concerned.
