Dear Sir:

This is in regard to your Scott & Lee well No. 1 in the T. 21N of Sec. 7, T. 18N., R. 27E., Elky County. As you know, we have written you several times regarding the filing of a proper bond covering operations on this well and as yet we have been unable to secure one.

It is my understanding that during the month of November, 1936, you produced 87 barrels of oil and during the month of December, 1936, you produced 67 barrels of oil.

Unless you file a proper bond before February 1, 1937, with the Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, New Mexico, your well will be shut down. See Circular No. 1, Rules and Regulations, of the Oil Conservation Commission.
