FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Well is to be plugged by pumping 15 sacks neat cement on bottom at 2096'. Hole to be filled with water and pump 30 sacks of neat cement at top of producing zone and extending into bottom of casing at 1704'. An 8 sack (30 foot) plug will be spotted at 350'. A 4" marker 5' long will be placed in top of well and cemented and marked showing well no. and location. All 7" casing will be left in well. The location will be cleared of all junk and leveled. This report corrects the C-102 dated May 15, 1959 which indicated that this well would be converted to fresh water.
