DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 3, 1940, set 510 ft. of 3/4" salt string approximately 21 ft. below the top of salt with the Halliburton process, cementing with 50 sacks of cement. Permitted the cement to set for 72 hours in order to test cement and water shut-off, then bailed the hole dry. Drilled cement plug and bailed hole dry again and let set for one hour before testing water shut-off. Result -- complete water shut-off. Resumed drilling operations.
