DETAILS OF WORK

On October 18, 1963 we ran 2245 feet of 4-1/2" - 9-1/2" casing - seamless; cementing same with 300 sacks Pacore Permix plus 50 sacks neat cement around the shoe. After cementing, we ran 1" on the outside of the 7" casing and cemented to the surface. Work was done by Halliburton.

This well is temporarily shut down and will be completed at an early date.

Electric and temperature log is attached.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
