G. There is no evidence of any archaeological, historical or cultural sites in the area.

H. Surface Ownership: The well site is on New Mexico state surface with Federal minerals. The State Land Office has been notified of this application to drill on their surface, with an agreement to comply with BLM requirements to restore the damaged surface area.
