We drilled to depth of 2296'. Encountered show of oil in sand at 1826'. Hole filled 1400' of fluid at 1843'. Ran 1843' of 7" csg. and mudded with 20 sacks mud. Drilled ahead to 2296' hole dry, ran 4 1/2" csg 11.6# to 2294' and pulled 7" csg. Then cemented 4 1/2" csg. with 300 sacks cement. Let stand 72 hours. W.O.C.
