January 9, 1990, this well was permanently plugged and abandoned using the following procedure:

Set a "cast iron" plug in 5-1/2" casing at 3200', loaded hole w/salt gel mud, placed 130' cement (13 sk.) on top of plug, spotted cement from 1997' to 1897' (10sk.), perforated 5-1/2" casing at 750' w/4 shots, broke circulation to the surface w/300 psi., set cement retainer in 5-1/2" casing at 700', circulated cement to the surface w/150 sks., loaded hole w/fresh water, spotted 150' cement on top of cement retainer, (15 sk.), placed 60' cement (6 sk.) at the surface. (All cement was class "C" cement) Installed dry hole marker with all well data.

January 11, 1990, the location was cleaned of all debris.

January 23, 1990, the location was ripped to a depth of 12" and an earthen barricade was installed to discourage vehicular travel.

January 26, 1990, the area was re-seeded w/5# alkali sacaton and 20# four wing salt brush. The surface restoration work has been completed and the area is ready for final inspection.
