Well presently producing from perforations 7700-7910' (32 holes).  
Propose to perforate 7824, 26, 28, 30 (2 SPF-8 holes); 7760, 62, 64 (2 SPF-6 holes)  
total 14 - .50" holes. Treat perforations in two stages with 700 gals 20% HCL acid.  
Treat all perforations 7700-7910' w/25000 gals 20% HCL in two equal stages with one  
drop of 800# graded rock salt and benzoic acid flakes in 10# gelled brine.  
Swab back and evaluate for sub-pump.
