MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN Yates Petroleum Corporation Hill View "AHE" Fed. Com. #5 660'FNL and 660'FEL Section 23-T208-R24E Eddy County, New Mexico

This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

Exhibit A is a portion of BLM map showing the well and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed wellsite is located approximately 31 miles southwest of Artesia, New Mexico, and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

DIRECTIONS:

- Go approximately 15 miles south of Artesia on Highway 285 to Rock Daisy Road.
- 2. Turn west and go approximately 8.2 miles to Sawbucks Road.
- 3. Turn south and go approximately 3.4 miles to Pickett Road.
- 4. Turn east and go approximately 1 mile. Turn on lease road going south.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD

- A. The proposed new access will be approximately 500' in length from point of origin to the southeast edge of the drilling pad. The road will lie in a west to east direction.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.
- C. The route of the road is visible.
