Notified BLM Answering Service, Carlsbad, NM. Lost circulation 205'. Drilling with 100% circulation at 207'. Ran 28 joints 9-5/8" 36# J-55 casing set 1220'. Guide shoe set 1220', insert float set 1176'. Cemented w/900 sx Pacesetter Lite "C" w/10#/sx Gilsonite + 1/2#/sx Celloseal + 3% CaCl2 (yield 1.84, wt 12.6). Tail in w/200 sx Class "C" w/2% CaCl2 (yield 1.32, wt 14.8). PD 8:45 AM 7-3-91. Bumped plug to 1100 psi, float held OK. Circulated 150 sacks cement. WOC. Drilled out 7:15 AM 7-4-91. WOC 22 hrs and 30 minutes. Reduced hole to 8-3/4" and resumed drilling.
