Per Al Springer's conversation with Shannon Shaw on August 27, 1993: Well will be spudded with a 26" hole on August 30th or August 31st. Will drill to 40' and set 20" conductor with ready mix to surface. NOTE: WILL BE SPURRED PRIOR TO THE FIRST OF SEPTEMBER.

WEK Drilling has been contracted to drill this well after they finish drilling a well for Mewbourne Operating at the end of August. Due to multiple drill stem tests and other delays, it will currently be approximately September 8th before they can move in and rig up to resume drilling for Yates Petroleum Corporation. BLM will again be notified prior to resuming drilling.
