
Please find enclosed herewith your approved copy of Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, the above captioned well. You will please note that we have made a change in regard to the surface casing and this is based on the information obtained from the drilling of the J. W. Baker No. 1 Rayroux, drilled with cable tools and located in the NE SE NE of Section 24, and had fresh water at 100 feet, fresh water at 502 to 505 feet, and sulphur water at 655 feet.

In view of this information, I think you should run at least 525 feet of 9 5/8" casing and cement with 150 sacks of cement to adequately protect the fresh water strata that we now know does exist in this area.

Thanking you for your cooperation in regard to this matter, I would also appreciate your furnishing me with a set of samples from surface to a depth of 1000 feet for the files of the Ground Water Supervisor of the State Engineers Office at Roswell, New Mexico.
