 6 5/8" casing cemented at 954' was knocked off and pulled from 538'.
 Stub of 10" casing from 223' to 417' left in hole. Hole was mudded to surface, spotting 20 sax cement plugs at total depth, at perforation 2378', stub of 7" at 1327', bottom of 6 5/8" at 954', stub of 6 5/8" at 538', and stub of 10" at 223'. Regulation marker was set in 10 sax plug at surface. Location cleaned and abandoned
