This well is making only a small amount of oil (less than 1 BOPD) and a large amount of water. Well data: 8-5/8" casing cemented at 729' with 225 sacks cement. Cement circulated to surface. 7" casing cemented at 1,468' with 155 sacks. Total depth is 1,687'. Estimated top of salt at 489'. Base of salt - 1,246'. Salt section is isolated by cement and casing at both top and bottom of salt.

It is proposed to plug and abandon well as follows:

1. Run 2" tubing to bottom. Spot 125 sx. class "C" cement with 1/4# Flo cell/sx. on bottom. Pull tubing to safe distance above cement and let cement set. Check top of plug.
2. Cement with an estimated 165 sacks class "C" cement back to approximately 350' from surface.
3. Spot 10 sacks of cement at surface with 4" pipe marker.

No casing will be pulled.

GEOLOGICAL SURVEY

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
