Dear Sir:

In regard to Texas International's request to drill a 12,700' well at the above location, attached please find the following:

- 1) Form 9-331C, Application to Drill.
- 2) Location Plat (NMOCC C-102's).
- 3) Designation of Operator (Form 9-1123) from Pennzoil Company.
- 4) Plat of location layout.
- 5) Small scale map of existing roads with proposed access road and well location.

In addition, please be advised of the following:

- 1) Mud pits will be steel.
- 2) No compsite or airstrip is proposed.
- 3) Tank battery will be located near or adjacent to corner of location pad.
- 4) Water supply to be either trucked in or secured from rancher in vicinity.
- 5) Land surface will be restored to as near original condition as possible and to satisfaction of USGS, following the cessation of all drilling and completion operations.
- 6) All detrimental waste will be disposed of observing all good disposal practices.
- 7) A mud program detail and brief drilling prognosis is attached.
- 8) A diagram of the proposed blow-out preventer hookup is attached.

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- 9) A pit volume totalizer will be used while drilling through any suspected abnormally high pressure zone.
