TD 2285'. Ran 51 joints of 9-5/8" 36# J-55 (2286.69') of casing set at 2285'. Float shoe set at 2285'. Float collar set at 2239.88'. Cemented with 200 sacks "H", 12% Thixad, 10#/sack gilsonite and 1/2#/sack celloseal (yield 1.56, weight 14.6) and 625 sacks Pacesetter Lite "C" (65-35-6), 5#/sack salt, 5#/sack gilsonite and 1/4#/sacks celloseal (yield 1.99, weight 12.5). Tailed in with 200 sacks Class C Neat 2% CaCl2 (yield 1.34, weight 14.8). PD 9:30 PM 9-2-94. Bumped plug to 1000#, OK. Circulated 190 sacks to pit. WOC. Drilled out at 9:45 PM 9-3-94. WOC 24 hours and 15 minutes. Nipped up and tested to 1000 psi for 15 minutes. Reduced hole to 8-3/4". Resumed drilling.
