Gentlemen:

This is to advise that the current status of the above referenced well has remained unchanged since Form C-103 was submitted June 8, 1976 (copy attached).

There has been a delay in plans for recompletion of the Sorenson "Com" #1 well. Forms C-101 (Application for Permit to Plug Back) and C-103 (Subsequent Report to Plug Back and Recomplete) were mailed to you 11/30/76, and should be in your office as of this date. AFE's were also mailed to partners for approval to plug back and recomplete in the Delaware Bell Canyon zone.

In view of the unforeseen delay relative to the recompletion operations on the Sorenson "Com" #1 well, we respectfully request further extension of a temporary abandonment status for the Terra State #2 well for a period of six (6) months until the recompletion test is finished, and evaluations are made. At that time a decision will be made to either go forward with the installation of surface SWD facilities or an application to permanently abandon the Terra State #2 will be submitted.
