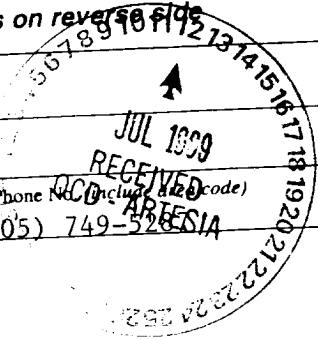

- Flow back and evaluate results.
- If successful, set production tubing and turn well to sales line. If not successful, set CIBP @ 10920'. Dump bail 35' cement. Test plug.
- Perforate Atoka Sand from 10778'-10794'.
- Flow test; frac if warranted.
- If successful, set production tubing and turn well to sales line. If not successful, well will be evaluated for future operations.

3 - Report the beginning or resumption of production as required by 43 CFR 3162.4-1(c).

4 - Analyze future applications for well operations in light of data obtained and methods used.

5 - Information from the record and/or the record will be transferred to appropriate Federal, State, local or foreign agencies when relevant to civil, criminal or regulatory investigations or prosecutions.
