We will be looking for you to reimburse us for any and all expenses that we may be faced with in this matter, and also we will be looking for our additional costs in investigating and handling of this matter.

If you have not contacted Mr. Armstrong's office by May 14, 1960, we will proceed in plugging this well, and in turn will make demand upon you to reimburse us for our cost.
